2. That your name will not cause any offence. Stay away from swear words or politics and things like vierkleur, swastikas, hammer and sickle, or satanical stuff or things that could cause religious or political or racial arguments.

Bike SA has been adopted over the years as the unofficial "register" of clubs, with proposed clubs writing in to state their intended name and other details and asking for any objections. Send club details to smalls@bikesa.net

Then wait a few months for any objections before continuing. It could be an expensive exercise to have to change patches and colours and names, so be patient. The word gets around quickly if there are problems.

Clubs can make their own rules and there is no central authority but remember that the biker brotherhood is a happy one, but also a proud and close one and is protective of biking's good name.

Joining a council is worth looking into but no club will be forced to join, or to abide by their rules. It will always be a voluntary choice, and any club can exist outside a council and are always welcome, as are non-club bikers, at rallies and jols and events - your entrance and bar money helps their finances, and you may just want to join a club while there. .

The club scene has progressed to where it is getting better organised and the councils and associations have been formed all over the country.
