ON TRACK: BMW CLUB RACING SERIES

➔ **The Bridgestone Track Challenge gives championship racers last chance to rack up points.**

This Sunday, the BMW Car Club Gauteng will host the final round of their 2015 Bridgestone Track Challenge, incorporating the Bridgestone BMW Club Racing Series, at the Red Star Raceway near Delmas.

While it will not be the first time a car club will make use of the racetrack, it is the first time a saloon car racing series will host an official round at the four-kilometre circuit that was originally designed for motorcycle racing.

The event will be the last chance for drivers in both the Time Trial and Race series championships to rack up points in their chase for the 2015 championship honours. In the Time Trial sessions, cars are let on to the track in sessions with cars of similar times in a race against the clock to set the best lap.

If you are a first-timer, the club also runs a Track School in the morning to get you comfortable with driving your car on a track and understand the necessary etiquette on a track day to stay out of trouble. If that is too much thrill, you can always strap yourself into a hot lap car where a professional driver will treat you to two flying laps for just R100.

The action will kick off at 8am on Sunday and carries on until 5pm.

Admission at the gate will be free for spectators, but if you want to participate there are fees involved. More information can be found at www.bmwcarclub.co.za.
